<u>Important Enrollment Information</u>: Pre-K enrollment for the 2018-2019 school year will be April 11<sup>th</sup> from 9 to 12 and 2 to 5. New Student Enrollment will be July 24<sup>th</sup> from 9 to 12 and July 25<sup>th</sup> from 2 to 6. Please bring a current vaccination record, proof of residency and a birth certificate. If you are not a resident, you will be required to fill out an emergency transfer request which will have to be approved by the Board. Transfer packets for returning students will be sent home March 26<sup>th</sup> and will need to be returned to school by April 3<sup>rd</sup>.

REVISION: ALL RETURNING IN-DISTRICT AND TRANSFER STUDENTS WILL NEED TO COME TO THE SCHOOL ON JULY 24<sup>TH</sup> OR JULY 25<sup>TH</sup> (during new student enrollment) AND FILL OUT NEW ENROLLMENT PACKETS. THIS IS REQUIRED OF ALL RETURNING STUDENTS.
