We are in our final 9 weeks and there is a lot going on so I want to encourage you to be diligent in looking for information coming home in your child's backpack as well as on our website and school Facebook page. A few of the important things that you need to be aware of are as follows. Everyone is asking about March 31st and wondering if Anderson will be out. Anderson **will not** be out for the 31st. While the district believes the rally is very important we have chosen to send a delegate of teachers to represent Anderson and the community in lieu of sending everyone and missing a day of instruction. **To be clear Anderson is in session March 31st.**

Another important issue that you all need to be aware of is emergency transfers. If your child is on an emergency transfer, you need to have your packet for the 2014-2015 school year turned in by April 15th. All emergency transfers turned in by the April 15th date will be reviewed at the May board meeting and you will be able to know if your student has been approved before the year is over. This way you will be able to properly plan for the next year concerning supplies and other necessities. I also want to remind everyone that Anderson is not currently accepting open transfers we only accept emergency transfers that have all four pages correctly completed. I know it is somewhat inconvenient but a transfer must be filled out every year. These transfers can be picked up in the office or printed off our website at andersontrojans.org.
