This student will also display a commitment to hard work, and a willingness to see the best in people. Selection criteria include academics, work experiences and participation in student, school, and community activities. All eligible students must complete this application form online.

### All applications must include the following:

A typed essay of less than 500 words as to why you are applying for this scholarship including a description of your high school and community activities, work experiences, and your intended career path.

A letter of recommendation from a high school teacher.

A copy of your high school transcript.

## DEBI SANDERS SCHOLARSHIP

The Debi Sanders Scholarship is given in honor of 25 years of distinguished service. Each year, \$1,000 will be awarded to a family member of any Keystone employee who is a senior in high school and plans to continue their education after high school. This student must display a dedication to service and a love for people, just like Debi. This student will also display a commitment to hard work, and a willingness to see the best in people. Selection criteria include academics, work experiences and participation in student, school, and community activities. All eligible students must complete this application form online.

### All applications must include the following:

A typed essay of less than 500 words as to why you are applying for this scholarship including a description of your high school and community activities, work experiences, and your intended career path.

A letter of recommendation from a high school teacher.

A copy of your high school transcript.
